President's Message

The "Gift" of Organizing

Several months ago I left a client's home with a huge donation of making supplies, "stuff" that my client spared no expense in acquiring how much my little Prius could hold! I posted on Facebook that I had these treasures to an organization that would use them. Immediately directed me to the Downtown Women's Center (DWC), a nonprofit organization whose mission is to provide permanent supportive housing and a safe environment that fosters dignity, respect, and personal stability.

The DWC has three facilities. I brought my donations to the one I had introduced myself and asked if the organization could use some of them. The staff behind the counter *whooped* with excitement! I toured the facility and discovered an amazing collection of clothing for homeless women. Ninety percent of the items for re-sale in their vintage clothing boutique on Hollywood Angeles St. They also host an online Etsy store featuring DWC-related and crafted goods. In addition, they provide micro-apartments, helping homeless women whose average age is 48. My tour included the "cages" located in the basement of the Los Angeles Street venue that could use the hands, ideas, and brain-power of professional organizers.

I brought the idea to your NAPO-LA Board who approved sponsoring an organizing event at the Downtown Women's Center on August 1 and 2 from 10:00 to 4:00 PM both days. Very exciting community service work for all of us!

We'll divide the basement into five areas: 1) sorting clothes, shoes, and accessories; 2) cleaning and repairing clothes; 3) organizing and labeling; 4) packing and shipping; 5) fundraising and marketing.

meet with him and simply revise what they already had. After all it was long and it was relatively painless. I cannot tell you how invaluable the binder was. Without the hassle of Probate, I was able to carry out what I had a roadmap tailor-made for me. I knew what to do and where the account, investment, and property was at my fingertips.

As my clients age, I'm urging them to prepare for their future - whether they have adult children, some have no kids at all, some have caring children and some of them do not. Because I'm the Professional Organizer for their homes (and set up their filing system), I know exactly where to find their information. I have my clients have me listed as part of their final instructions. They provide the information to their attorneys and CPAs so, when that time comes the probate process flow smoothly.

There are so many things to take care of when someone passes away: What about their digital footprint? I attended "Advance Planning for Your Virtual Afterlife" at the NAPO Conference. It opened up an entirely new aspect of "advance planning" that occurred to me: What happens to your Facebook page or Twitter account when you die? What happens to your eBay and Amazon accounts? Yes, we need various passwords for security; however, we also need someone to manage them when we no longer can.

It can be overwhelming for our clients when they think about everything that needs to be planned. That's where Professional Organizers come in. Approach your clients with wishes, digital afterlife, and further planning with your clients. Test your clients which clients have their plans in place. Some clients may want to be buried in the sand - others will thank you for your concern. While making plans for yourself. Only you know exactly how you'd want to be buried.
